Hoonah Subsistence Fishing and Fishing Industry COVID-19 Agreement

This “Agreement” is between the undersigned company or person (herein, collectively “Person”) and the City of Hoonah (the “City”). Person acknowledges and agrees to the terms and conditions of this Agreement because COVID-19 is a national pandemic that is a substantial risk to public health, safety and welfare within Hoonah. Person is permitted to engage in subsistence and commercial fishing or fish processing in and around Hoonah because Person acknowledges measures must be taken to protect Person and its personnel and the Hoonah community, from the spread of COVID-19. The Hoonah

Mayor must sign this Agreement before Person and its personnel is permitted to travel to Hoonah.

1. Person must email the Hoonah City Administrator at dgray@cityofhoonah.org, 48-hours prior to travel to Hoonah, the following documents for consideration by the Hoonah City Administrator, Hoonah Mayor and Hoonah Chief of Police: (A) a copy of this Agreement signed by Person; (B) Person’s travel plan or protocol that Person submitted to the Alaska Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development pursuant to State Health Mandate 010 or 012; (C) Person’s plan for how Person intends to quarantine Person and its personnel who develop a fever, sore throat, cough, shortness of breath, chills, body aches, headache, abdominal pain, diarrhea or vomiting (herein, collectively “Symptoms”) while in Hoonah; and (D) Person’s plan for how Person intends to provide medical evacuations for Person and its personnel.
2. Person ensures compliance by Person and its personnel with the City’s Temporary COVID-19 Emergency Resolutions and Rules and State Health Mandates, as amended, and the documents listed in Section 1 of this Agreement to the greatest extent possible, all of which are incorporated into and a part of this Agreement.
3. Person and its personnel have been screened for Symptoms a minimum of 48-hours (“Health Screening”) prior to travel to Hoonah, and individuals that manifested any Symptoms during screening were prohibited from traveling to Hoonah. Person will monitor its personnel for symptoms of COVID-19, assist personnel with accessing testing in the event that personnel display symptoms of COVID-19, and notify the City in writing at dgray@cityofhoonah.org of any personnel in Hoonah who have tested positive for COVID-19 within 24 hours of receiving notice of the positive test result. If requested by the City, Person and its personnel must submit to Health Screening by the City while in Hoonah, and the City may expel Person or its personnel from Hoonah for failure to submit to Health Screening or manifestation of any Symptoms.
4. Person and its personnel, for 14-days period after arrival in Hoonah, must self-quarantine and limit travel to between Person’s subsistence area or work location and vessel or lodging in Hoonah.
5. Person and its personnel, during their time in Hoonah, must wear face coverings as recommended in State Health Alert 010 when outside personnel lodging in Hoonah, and are prohibited from: (A) physical interaction with residents of Hoonah; (B) entering residences in Hoonah that are not personnel lodging; and (C) using laundromats, grocery stores, convenience stores and hardware stores. Person and its personnel must arrange for delivery of food and other necessary items to Person’s and its personnel’s subsistence area, work location, vessel or lodging in Hoonah. Person can purchase fuel for their vessel at local fueling facility in Hoonah, but cannot leave vessel while fueling.
6. Person requesting haul out of Person’s vessel have two options: (A) vessel lifted and crew must depart by second vessel, and hauled out vessel will be blocked by the City personnel – third-party may commence outside work on hauled out vessel immediately, interior work may not commence until hauled out vessel is quarantined for 3-days; or (B) Person or its personnel may commence work on vessel in compliance with this Agreement.
7. Person and its personnel may depart and return to Hoonah in a vessel to engage in subsistence and commercial fishing or fish processing. If Person or personnel visit any they must self-quarantine as required by this Agreement.
8. If Person or its personnel breach a term or condition of this Agreement, the City shall have all remedies available to it under the law, including expedited court order enjoining activity that violates this Agreement. Person shall pay the City’s full attorney’s fees and costs associated with the enforcement of this Agreement.
