Effective Thursday, November 12, 2020 Hoonah Requirements for In-State Travelers

Step 1. All incoming travelers must provide proof of a negative COVID-19 test taken within 72 hours (3 days) of arrival into Hoonah OR commit to **FREE** testing provided by the City of Hoonah in partnership with Hoonah Indian Association. This free testing will be provided at the airport when planes are in, or ferry terminal when ferries are in port. If coming by private boat or private plane, please call HIA at 945-3545 to set up an appointment for a free test.

Step 2. With a negative COVID-19 test you are required to practice strict social distancing for 72 hours. You are allowed to be in an outdoor public place, but you must remain six feet away from anyone not in your immediate household and must wear a face covering. You **CANNOT** enter stores, restaurants, bars, gyms, community centers, office buildings, and school or daycare facilities. Do not participate in any group activities, including sporting events and practices, weddings, funerals, or other gatherings.

Step 3. You are required to take a second free test after 72 hours (3 days) of arrival into Hoonah. You can take this second free test by going to the airport or ferry terminal when a ferry or plane is in, or by calling HIA to set up an appointment.
