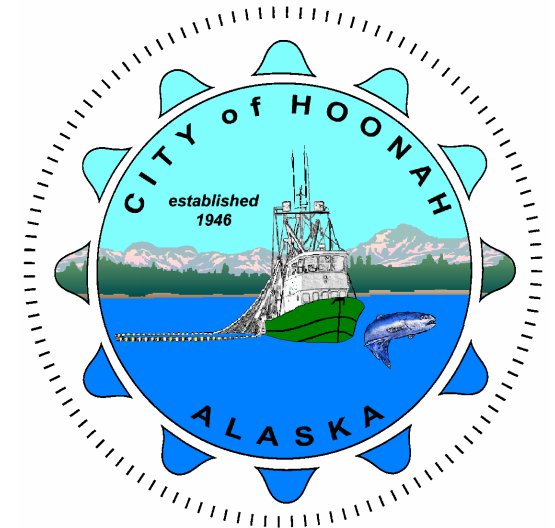

**SENIOR CITIZENS TAX
EXEMPT CARD**

HOW TO QUALIFY FOR A SENIOR CITIZEN TAX EXEMPT CARD

- A. You must be 65 years of age.
- B. You must be a resident of Hoonah for at least 30 days prior to applying. A resident of Hoonah means a person who is physically present in the city of Hoonah with the intent to remain in the city indefinitely and to make a home in the city.
- C. Proof of residency and intent to remain in the city:
 - 1. Two pieces of identification:
 - A. Alaska Drivers License or ID Card with Hoonah Address
 - B. Voter Registration Card showing Hoonah Address
 - 2. Rental agreement or mortgage payment showing proof of 30 day occupancy OR Travel arrangements showing date of arrival OR Letter from employer starting start date.
- D. You may not claim residency in another city, state, country, or perform other acts or be absent under circumstances that are inconsistent with the intent to remain a resident of the city.

HOW MAY I USE MY CARD

The card entitles you upon presentation to seller to be exempt from general city sales tax only.

The card does not exempt sales tax for the following:

1. Alcoholic beverages, tobacco products,
2. Rentals of hotel rooms as transients,
3. Sales of pull tabs, bingo or other charitable games
4. Goods or services purchased for the use in any trade or business, or
5. purchases for which the card holder is reimbursed or remunerated by a person or entity on whose behalf the purchase was made and who would not otherwise qualify for a sales tax exemption.

Violations: Any person who violates any provision of this section is guilty of a violation and, upon conviction, shall be fined in an amount not to exceed \$100.00. The tax-exempt card shall then be void and it shall be forfeited to and cancelled by the city treasurer.

Processing of application may take up to five days. Cards will be mailed to you at the address provided.
